**- J'ai tant de tantes. Quelle tante m'attend?**

**- Ta tante Antoine t'attend**

(- Your aunt is waiting for you.

- I have so many aunts. Which aunt is waiting for me?

- Your aunt Antoine is waiting for you)

**Tonton, ton thé t'a-t-il ôté ta toux?**

(Uncle, has your tea got rid of your cough?)

**Si six scies scient six cyprès,  
six cent six scies scient six cent six cyprès**

(If six saws saw six cypresses,  
six hundred and six saws saw six hundred and six cypresses)

**Les chaussettes de l'archi-duchesse,  
sont-elles sèches ou archi-sèches?**

(The socks belonging to the arch-duchess,  
are they dry or arch-dry?)
